Important Reminders

These tips may enhance your disposal and recycling experience.

<u>Locks</u>. Walk-In and Estate service subscribers should inspect lockbox or combination locks used by our crews to access your waste storage area to be sure they are functioning properly. Rusted and broken locks prevent us from entering properties to perform service.

<u>Addresses</u>. To avoid misplaced containers, please mark your house number on the lids of your trash cart, recycling cart and, if applicable, your green waste cart with a permanent marker or paint.

<u>Property Sale</u>. If you are selling your home, please remember to cancel your auto-pay arrangement online or by calling our office.

<u>Auto-Pay</u>. Online registration and online bill pay are available 24/7. If you are selling your home, please remember to cancel your auto-pay arrangement online at <u>www.palmspringsdisposal.com</u>.

<u>6 AM</u>. Curbside service subscribers should place carts at the curb on collection day by 6 A.M.

Recyclable Materials

These materials can be placed in your **BLUE CART** to be recycled:

Aluminum cans, antifreeze bottles, food jars & bottles, assorted plastics, baby food jars, beer bottles, brochures, cardboard, catalogues, cereal boxes, computer paper, condiment jars, crayon drawings, egg cartons, envelopes, food boxes, fruit & vegetable cans, jam & jelly jars, juice boxes, juice cans, junk mail, metal coat hangers, magazines, mixed paper, milk cartons, newspapers, pet food cans, plastic grocery bags, plastic laundry jugs, plastic soda bottles, shampoo/lotion bottles, soda & beer cartons, soda cans, Styrofoam, telephone books, tissue boxes, toilet paper & paper towel tubes, wine & liquor bottles, wrapping paper. The list keeps growing.

Free E-waste Drop-Off

We accept Electronic waste for recycling at our Palm Springs facility Monday thru Friday between 8 A.M. and 3:30 P.M. A self-help E-waste collection cage is located next to our driveway off Williams Road. Small household batteries can be placed in the same E-waste cage. We partner with Desert Arc to disassemble and recycle electronic components as a job-training program for their clients.

Household Hazardous Waste

Household Hazardous Waste (paint, pesticides, cleaners, chemicals, antifreeze, etc.) cannot be disposed in the trash. The County of Riverside operates a public Household Hazardous Waste Facility, 1100 Vella Road, Palm Springs. The hours are 7:00 AM to Noon on non-holiday weekend Saturday's. The facility, located just south of the Palm Springs Animal Shelter, will be closed July 1st and September 2nd. (The facility will return to normal hours on October 7th.)
