Recycling Highlights

Subscribers to **Walk-In and Estate** services are reminded that if you utilize a lock box or combination lock to inspect gate locks to make sure that they are working properly. Broken or inoperable locks prevent our collectors from gaining entry to perform collection services.

Document Shredding & E-Waste Event

A free document shredding and E-Waste recycling event begins at **8 A.M. on October 15th** in the City Hall parking lot, 3200 E. Tahquitz Canyon Way.

Documents are limited to 3 containers per vehicle, per day (container size: 9" x 13" x 17").

Electronic equipment (computers, monitors, microwaves, keyboards, printers, cell phones, fax machines and batteries AAA, AA, C, D, button, 9-volt & rechargeables) will be collected and dismantled & recycled.

Tires, household hazardous waste, appliances, trash, car batteries and air conditioning or heating units **WILL NOT** be accepted.

aluminum cans, antifreeze bottles, food jars & bottles, assorted plastics, baby food jars, beer bottles, brochures, cardboard, catalogues, cereal boxes, computer paper, condiment jars, crayon drawings, egg cartons, envelopes, food boxes, fruit & vegetable cans, jam & jelly jars, juice boxes, juice cans, junk mail, metal coat hangers, magazines, mixed paper, milk cartons, newspapers, pet food cans, plastic grocery bags, plastic laundry jugs, plastic soda bottles, shampoo/lotion bottles, soda & beer cartons, soda cans, Styrofoam, telephone books, tissue boxes, toilet paper & paper towel tubes, wine & liquor bottles, wrapping paper. Curbside. The Fall, 2016 curbside collection event will start Monday, October 17th (for single-family residents ONLY). You do not need to contact us to arrange a collection. Place up to two bulky items OR four containers of excess trash OR two bundles of yard waste at the curb by 6:00 A.M., Monday, October 17th. Our crews will make one pass through the City during the week collecting these items. This is a FREE event.

Drop Off. If you prefer to drop off bulky items or trash, you may drop off waste at the Palm Springs City Hall parking lot, 3200 E. Tahquitz Canyon Way. Drop-offs will be accepted on Saturday, October 22nd ONLY, 8 A.M. to 2 P.M. Waste from commercial landscapers and contractors is not accepted. This is a FREE event for P.S. residents.
